Exhibitors will receive exhibit space, a table and chairs, two admissions/lunch tickets, and their company name listed in the proceedings and on www.dairysymposium.com. We have two exhibit space sizes available for your convenience and optional access to electricity for a fee. Additional admission/lunch tickets can be purchased for \$30.00.

Exhibit spaces will be pre-assigned based on <u>paid registration on a first-come</u>, <u>first-serve basis</u>. In order to secure a preferable exhibit space, register promptly. Exhibitor spaces will be available until January 10, 2026, or until exhibitor space capacity is reached.

Doors open for set-up from 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and doors open to the public at 9:00 a.m. Exhibitor registration gets you the space and access to a table and chairs, but all other aspects of the display, such as extension cords, table coverings, etc., are your responsibility. **Exhibitors are expected to exhibit until 4:00 p.m.** to allow producers to walk through the exhibitor halls after the speaking program has concluded.

On arrival:

- Exhibitors are required to register at the desk in the foyer of the Oxford Auditorium. You will receive a nametag
 with your registration package.
- YOU MUST WEAR THE NAME TAG AT ALL TIMES. This nametag gets you in and out of the building and
 is your lunch pass.
- Once registered at the front desk, bring in your exhibit through the door nearest your exhibit. Alternate entrances will be monitored to ensure exhibitors enter at the main entrance before setting up their booth.
- After you have set up your exhibit, we would appreciate it if you would park your vehicle in the Civic Centre parking lot. Bus service will be provided.
